<p><b>Q21</b>  <b>Statement:</b> Reports of steep and continued decline in the inflows into the Gobindsagar reservoir of the Bhakra Dam, coupled with a depleted stock of coal with the thermal power plants in the North, may lead to a serious power crisis in the region.  <b>Action I:</b> The supply of coal to the thermal power plant should be immediately stepped up by the Government  <b>Action II:</b> The Government should set up hydraulic power plants on other rivers in the region.</p>	<p>ONLY Action I follows</p>
